## RESPONSIBILITIES OF RESEARCHERS

## Australian Code for the Responsible Conduct of Research 2018

- Support a culture of responsible research conduct at **R14** their institution and in their field of practice.
- Adopt methods appropriate to the aims of the research **R21** and ensure that conclusions are justified by the results.
- Provide guidance and mentorship on responsible R15 research conduct to other researchers or research trainees under their supervision and, where appropriate, monitor their conduct.
- Retain clear, accurate, secure and complete records of all research including research data and primary materials. **R22** Where possible and appropriate, allow access and reference to these by interested parties..
- Undertake and promote education and training in **R16** responsible research conduct.
- Disseminate research findings responsibly, accurately **R23** and broadly. Where necessary, take action to correct the record in a timely manner.
- Comply with the relevant laws, regulations, disciplinary standards, ethics guidelines and institutional policies **R17** related to responsible research conduct. Ensure that appropriate approvals are obtained prior to the commencement of research, and that conditions of any approvals are adhered to during the course of research.
- Disclose and manage actual, potential or perceived **R24** conflicts of interest.

- Ensure that the ethics principles of research merit and **R18** integrity, justice, beneficence and respect are applied to human research.
- Ensure that authors of research outputs are all those, and only those, who have made a significant intellectual or **R25** scholarly contribution to the research and its output, and that they agree to be listed as an author.

- Engage with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander **R19** peoples and respect their legal rights and local laws, customs and protocols.
- **R26 Acknowledge** those who have contributed to the research.

- Ensure that the 3Rs (Replacement, Reduction and Refinement) are considered at all stages of research **R20** involving animals and minimise the impacts on animals used in research and in so doing support the welfare and wellbeing of these animals.
- Cite and acknowledge other relevant work appropriately **R27** and accurately.
- Participate in peer review in a way that is fair, rigorous **R28** and timely and maintains the confidentiality of the content.
- Report suspected breaches of the Code to the relevant **R29** institution and/or authority.
