Position Description:

Roles & Responsibilities:

- Serve as ambassadors of Curtin Sport and Recreation to the university community
- Meeting monthly with other Advisory Group members to collaborate ideas and discuss issues regarding sport & recreation at Curtin University
- Provide feedback and recommendations to Curtin Sport and Recreation regarding operations, initiatives & programs
- Communicating with students and providing correct information to get involved

Desirable attributes:

- Experience in dealing with a wide variety of people
- An outgoing and approachable nature
- Previous experience sitting on a committee or board will be looked upon favourably
- Experience within University Sport or Curtin Sports Clubs

Personal attributes:

- Ability to work as part of a team
- Enthusiastic and motivated approach
- A willingness to share ideas and collaborate with others

Expectations:

- Advisory group members are expected to attend all monthly meetings. Missing 2 or more meetings may result in that member being removed from the Student Advisory Group.
- All appointments to the advisory board will be for a term of 1 year. Applicants should ensure that they can commit for the duration of their appointment prior to making any application.

Eligibility

Students need to be currently enrolled at Curtin University at the time of their appointment to the Student Advisory Group.
