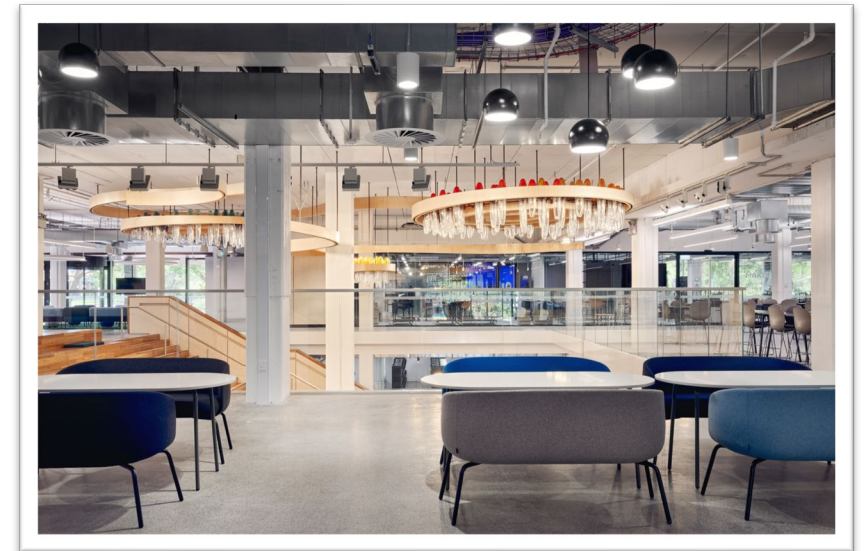


- Ample new study spaces for groups and individuals and bookable study spots, many with white boards and AV capabilities.

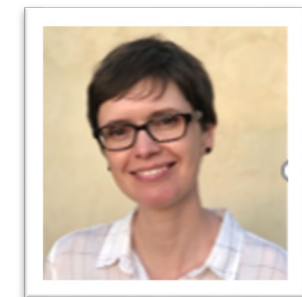

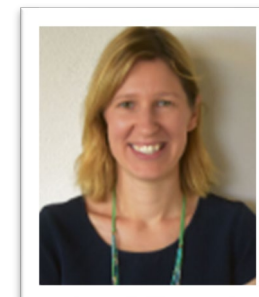
